

Notification for Post-matric Scholarship (PMS) for students belonging to the notified Minority Communities for the year 2015-16.

Under the Scheme, Post-matric Scholarship (PMS) for students belonging to the notified Minority Communities (Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Parsi, Jain) scholarships are awarded to the meritorious students who have secured not less than **50% marks or equivalent grade** in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian, **from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2.00 lakh.**

Salary certificate from the employer for employed parents/guardian in original or Income Certificate to be issued by the Competent Authority declared by that State Government (Tehsildar Concerned) in original for Non-Employed parents/Guardian will be accepted. **Fee receipt of "Current Course Year" in original will be accepted. Photocopy or scan of Income certificate/Fee receipt will not be entertained.**

The Online Scholarship Management System (OSMS) has already been introduced in the Post-matric Scholarship scheme, from the year 2012-13. The site was accessed through the URL. www.momascholarship.gov.in. However, from 2015-16, the online implementation of the Post-matric Scholarship will be done through the common National Scholarship Web Portal of the Government of India, under URL www.scholarships.gov.in. A link to the site is also made available in the website of this Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. **Only Online applications under the Scheme will be accepted and no request for offline applications will be entertained.**

The Scholarship will be sanctioned through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode, which means that the scholarship sanctioned in favour of eligible students would be directly, credited into their Bank accounts by the Ministry of Minority Affairs. Therefore, it is mandatory to provide Bank account number with complete details upto 16 digits A/c number with IFSC code, MICR Code & Branch code. **Further, all the students should necessarily have bank account in their own name. If the Bank account is in the name of any of the family member, Scholarship would not be credited into their bank account.**

The students studying in Jammu Division are advised to take print-out of the dully filled-in applications forms, after submitting it online and to send it alongwith all supporting documents through their respective Institutes where they are studying who in turn would forward it online and offline to the District Social Welfare Officer of the district where the institution falls. In case of students studying outside the state, the Head of the Institutions are advised to send the hard copies alongwith all supporting documents of the students of J&K to the respective District Social Welfare Office, where the student is residing.

The National Scholarship Web portal provides uploading facility for uploading all required documents by the Students. The DSWOs while verifying these documents may exercise due diligence for their validation.
