### ▶ **DISTRICT REASI – AN OVERVIEW**

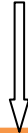

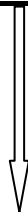

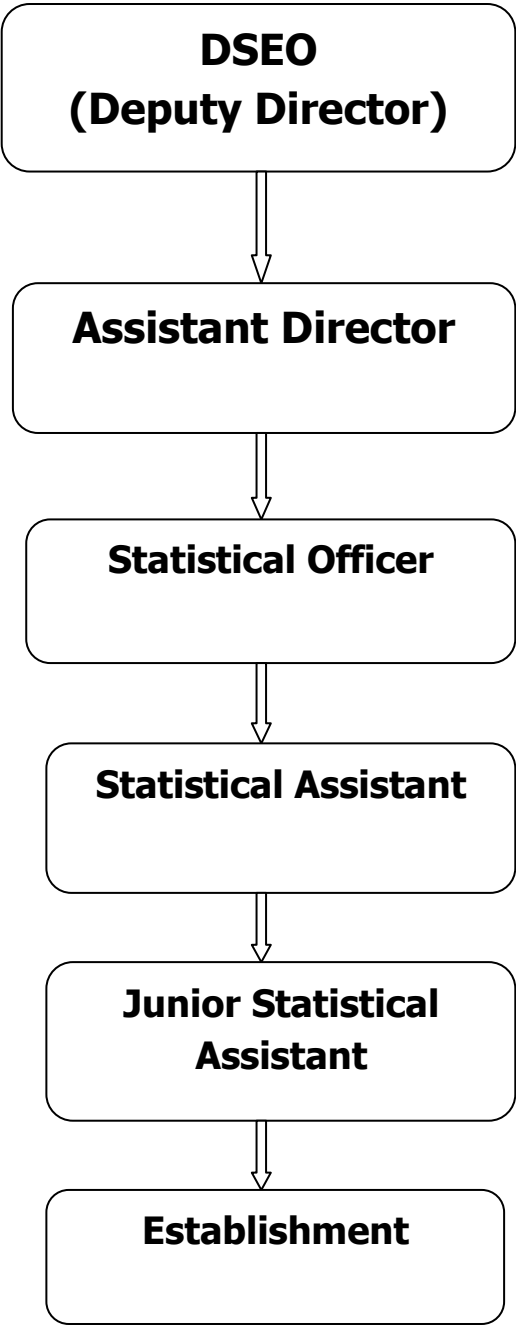

### ▶ **FUNCTIONS OF DSEO OFFICE:**

- **Publications** – Publication of various Official Documents such as District Statistical Handbook, District At a Glance, District Economic Review etc.
- **Evaluation** – To assess the impact and outcome of different Projects / Programmes / Schemes funded by Centre Govt. or State Govt. or by both, the Evaluation Studies at District Level as assigned by the Govt. has to be conducted by the DSEO office.
- **Physical Verifications** - DSEO Office has also assigned with the job of conducting the physical verification of different infrastructural projects / Schemes allotted by Planning & Development Department Civil Secretariat J&K Govt from time to time.
- **National Sample Survey** - DSEO Office has also assigned the job of conducting the socio-economic survey-an assignment of

MOSPI, GOI. Under such survey, samples have been provided in shape of sub-rounds during the calendar year. At present 72<sup>nd</sup> Round of NSS is in progress. The filled in Schedules of the same sent to the office of DG, E&S, J&K Jammu for punching and for report writing.

- **Employment and Unemployment Survey** - Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour & Employment, GOI, Chandigarh also entrusted the job for conducting such survey to DSEOs round the calendar year through the office of DG E&S, J&K. During 2014, 4<sup>th</sup> Round of Annual Survey was conducted and the filled in Schedules of 08 samples have been submitted to the concerned Ministry.
- **Vital Statistics (Civil Regn. System)** - Registration of Birth and Death Act 1969, make it compulsory for every citizen to get registration of their Birth and Death. For collecting the Data regarding Births and Deaths, DSEO act as the Additional District Registrar Birth and Death at the District level. The filled in Schedules of Births and Deaths of said data has been collected from Executive Officer in the Urban Areas and from SHOs in the Rural Areas.
- **Price Statistics** - District Statistics & Evaluation has also assigned with the job of collecting price statistics of essential commodities on the devised formats from the local market on weekly basis. Besides, price statistics regarding livestock products from Agriculture, Sheep Husbandry, Animal Husbandry and Sericulture Departments has also been collected on six monthly basis. The data so collected has been compiled and submitted in the shape of monthly / six monthly progress reports to the Office of Director General, Economics & Statistics, J&K.
