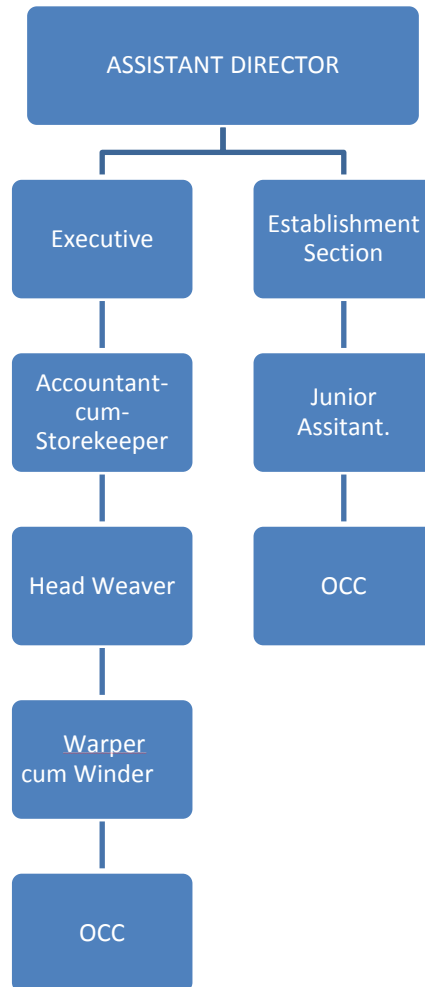

Functions of the Department

A) Training Programme:

The prime activity of the department is to impart training to all enrolled candidates in the Handloom Weaving Training Centre. At present, there is one (01) training centre functioning at Buttan in District Reasi, imparting training in Handloom Weaving. The sanctioned strength of training centre is 10. The department is providing stipend @ Rs. 500/- per month to each trainee.

B) Registration of Weavers:

The trainees trained in our training centres can seek Registration with the department for pursuing Self-employment and to avail benefits of various Schemes of the department. Besides this, the non-trainees (Persons got training at their own in trades recognized by the department for various schemes) on the basis of Practical test conducted by the department can also seek registration and avail benefits of various Schemes of the department.

C) Awareness Camps/Exhibitions:

The department participates in various Exhibitions organised by the District Administration as well as Directorate of Handloom. As a part of Marketing initiative, the department also provides opportunity to all registered Handloom Industrial Co-op. Societies to participate in various State & National level Exhibitions for selling their products. The department also organises Awareness Camps for generating awareness regarding various schemes among common masses in general & Weavers in particular.

D) Weaver Credit Card (WCC) Scheme:

The WCC Scheme aims at providing adequate and timely assistance from the Banking Institutions to the registered Weavers to meet their credit requirements. The maximum amount to be sanctioned under the Scheme is Rs. 2.00 Lacs. At present, the department provides Interest Subsidy @ 6%. There is provision of margin money assistance @ 20% of loan

amount with maximum of Rs. 10,000/- per weaver. Both the Interest subvention and margin money component are borne by NABARD.

E) Micro Credit Plan Scheme:

The Scheme aims at providing easy and soft credit to the registered Weavers engaged in different Handloom activities (only those activities which are covered by the department). The Weavers can take benefit of 10% Interest Subsidy up to loan amount of Rs. 1.00 Lac.

F) Loan for Renovation/Modernization of Looms:

Under this scheme, the assistance is provided in the shape of 50% subsidy & 50% Loan. The loan component is recoverable in 10 annual installments with interest @ 9.25%. Loan under this scheme is given to registered cooperative societies only.

G) Share Capital Loan/Purchase of Raw-Material:

Under the scheme, the loan is given to the society for meeting its Raw Material requirements. The loan so provided is recovered in 10 equal yearly installments along with 9.25% interest per annum. Loan under this scheme is given to registered cooperative societies only.

H) Education Scheme:

Under the scheme, the school going Girl children of Weavers of Handloom Industrial Cooperative Societies are being paid scholarship as detailed under:

I) Mahatma Gandhi Bima Bunkar Yojana:

The scheme is being implemented by the Handloom Development Department in collaboration with LOC of India to provide the Life Insurance cover to the Handloom Weavers.

Beside this the two children of weaves covered under MGBBY studying in class 9th to 12th are provided with scholarship @ Rs.1200 per year by LIC of India.

I) Health insurance Scheme:

In order to provide Health Insurance cover to Weaver Family, Handloom Development Department is implementing this scheme in collaboration with ICICI Lombard. Under this scheme the weaver family (4 Members) are entitle to free treatment up to 15000-00 per year.

The break up of the premium is as under:

J) Formation of Handloom Industrial Cooperative Societies:

The registered weaves can form Handloom Industrial cooperative Societies and seek registration from Director Handloom Development Department, J&K. The minimum strength required for the formation of a society is **11**. The Department provides financial assistance to registered Handloom Societies under various schemes of the department.
