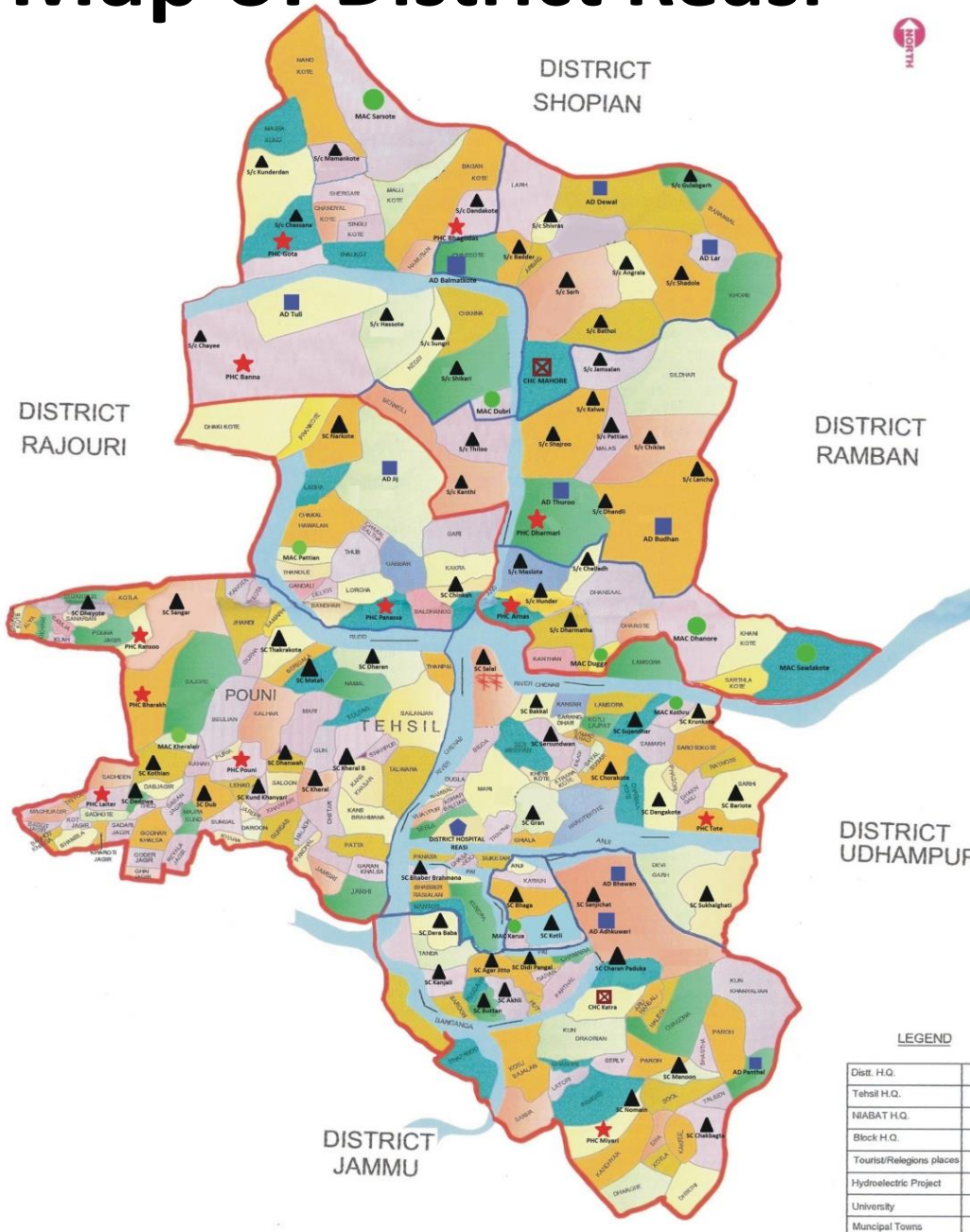







Health Department

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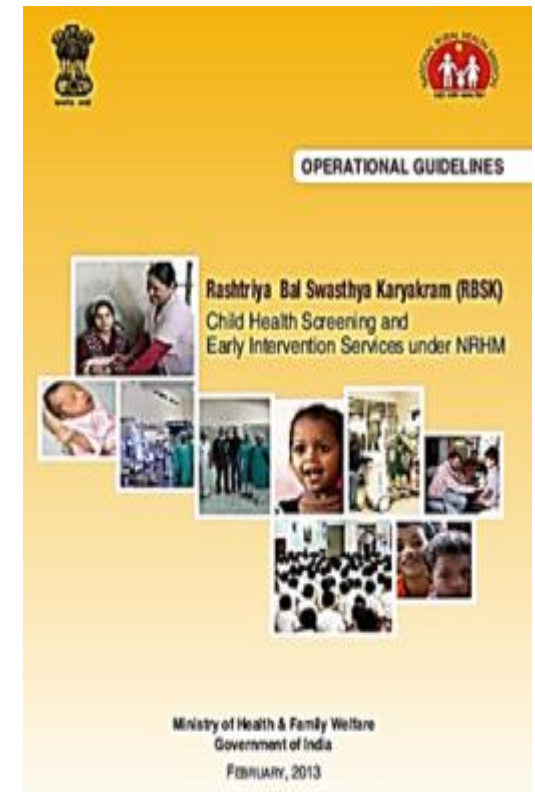

An Overview of Child health screening and early intervention services

Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK)

- **Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram** is an initiative to improve child Survival & Quality of life.
- It is a systemic approach to early identification of **4Ds: Defects at birth, Diseases, Deficiencies and Developmental delays including Disabilities** in children 0 to 18 years of age.
- Existing **School health programme under NRHM** is now expanded to include comprehensive screening for all children: Scheme is expected to cover more than **27 crore** children in a phased manner.
- This initiative ensures free management and treatment including surgical interventions at tertiary level through NRHM.
